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HOSPITAL COURSE

POST CATH FEMALE

Patient was admitted and consent was obtained for cardiac catheterization. She was prepped and taken to the cath lab where she underwent cardiac catheterization with successful PCI/stenting of the LAD utilizing a 3.0 x 28 mmXience Sierra DES via the right radial approach. The patient tolerated the procedure well without complications and a TR band was placed on the right wrist. She was returned to her room in stable condition. She was monitored overnight and tolerated po intake as well as ambulated without difficulties. The following morning, she was felt suitable for dismissal. She was provided with detailed follow up instructions and appropriate prescriptions prior to discharge.

11/9/20: LHC, selective coronary angiography, LV gram
- successful PCI/stenting of the LAD utilizing a 3.0 x 28 mmXience Sierra DES
